Amendment to the
Milford Borough Outdoor Food Consumption
Ordinance No. 2021 - _____

This is an Ordinance of Milford Borough amending **Sections 312-11** and adding **Section 312-26** pertaining to Outdoor Food Consumption.

WHEREAS, the Milford Borough Council has determined that it is necessary to clarify the Definitions of food establishment outdoor dining area food items and to further clarify the existing Zoning Ordinance as to where outdoor food consumption may be allowed for establishments and does hereby Adopt the following Ordinance dealing with outdoor food consumption:

312-11 Definitions

Porch. An outdoor structure that is attached to or projects from the main building with a roof that is usually open at the sides.

Food Establishment. A restaurant or a food store properly permitted for preparation and sale of food items (including liquid items).

Outdoor Dining Area. An area for the dispensing, serving and consumption, but not the preparation, of food and beverages, provided such use is attached to a principal use of a restaurant or other food establishment.

Food Item. A raw, cooked, or processed edible substance, ice, beverage, or ingredient used or intended for use or for sale in whole or in part for human consumption. Food includes ice, water or any other beverage, food ingredients and chewing gum.

312 Zoning, Article V, Supplementary Regulations

§ 312-26 Outdoor Food Consumption

A. A food establishment is permitted to allow the consumption of food items in an outdoor dining area with the following requirements:

(1) The outdoor space must be directly adjacent to the building and must conform to all

- (6) The outside dining area shall be subject to Chapter 198, Noise. All activities, including the playing of music or other forms of entertainment, shall comply with the noise limitations of the Borough Code and any other regulatory agencies having jurisdiction, as applicable.
- (7) There must be a physical barrier (fence or shrubbery) between the outside seating area and parking lots or adjacent properties.
