I am writing to express my continued complaint about the lights on the rear of the SNK Fuels gas station shining into my bedroom windows at 102 Broad Street. These lights are extremely bright, and even if their candlepower is within legal limits, they are spilling well past the property line. Further, one of the lights is directed straight at my bedroom windows.

I have observed them from the ground behind the SNK Fuels building, and they appear to be easily adjusted to be directed at the ground so they will not spill past the property line. The one directed straight my bedroom windows also appears to be easily swiveled away from the direction of my home as well.

I read about the discussions of various violations of zoning ordinances at this building at a recent Borough Council meeting, and hope that issues regarding these lights, among them, will be pursued by the council.
